





Lessons Learned – Summary for the Evaluator

- Easier to follow what the users are doing in remote user testing
 - than on-site user testing
 - You see it clearly on the screen
- Very good that a developer was conducting the user testing
 - Saw the importance of the UI
 - Encourages the developer to work 24/7
- Have to be very careful with the preparation
 - Have Teams installed
 - Make an invite for the user testing
 - Send an email in advance

My Lessons Learned

- Much harder to understand the context of the user
 - · I have learned so much by going to the real context of use
- The users are more distant
